

#### **Communities**

 This project will enhance safety for all road users (motorists, pedestrians and bicyclist) by upgrading pedestrian and vehicular signalization and adding a second right-turn lane

Stormwater drainage improvements will help alleviate ponding

## Roadway Project




### **Project Scope**

- Adding a second right-turn lane from southbound (SB) Indian Creek Drive to westbound (WB) 41 Street
- Adding signalization at 41 Street for the SB dual right turn lanes
- Repaving and restriping the road
- Upgrading pedestrian ramps to meet the American with Disability Act (ADA) standards and crossings at signalized intersections
- Reconstructing damaged sidewalk and curb and gutter
- Adjusting manholes and valves
- Removing parking
- Upgrading signage
- Upgrading bicycle lane
- Relocating or trimming existing landscape
- Fixing stormwater drainage inlets












#### **Typical Section of SR A1A/Indian Creek Drive**

## **Bridge Project**





### **Project Scope**

- Repairing the bridge deck
- Rehabilitating the bridge features above and below including handrails, columns, etc.
- Replacing deck expansion joints
- Rehabilitating the bridge foundation

### What to Expect During Construction

Construction activities will be completed in phases to minimize impacts to the public.

Pedestrian detours will be clearly marked.



Travel lanes may be closed only during nonpeak hours and on nonevent days.

#### Nonpeak hours are:

Daytime: 10 AM to 2 PM

Nighttime: 8 PM to 5:30 AM



### What to Expect During Construction



### **Posted Speed:**

Existing 35 miles per hour speed limits will be maintained during construction



#### **Dust:**

 The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust



### What to Expect During Construction



#### Noise:

Some noise should be expected during allowable construction time



#### Access:

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
